The regular monthly meeting of the highway commissioners of the State of Illinois, County of St. Clair, and Township of Prairie Du Long was held in the office of the town clerk at the Prairie Du Long Township Office Building on November 12, 2024 at 7:30 P.M.

Supervisor Mike Karban called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those present.

Mike Karban, Township Supervisor, presided over the meeting. Trustees John Kaiser, Tim Lubenkov, Kyle Row, Dean Skaer, Road Commissioner Gilbert Birkner and Township Clerk Dana Mehrmann were present.

Supervisor Karban asked the Clerk to read the minutes from the previous meeting. Mr. Karban asked for questions or comments regarding the minutes. Kyle Row motioned to accept the minutes as read. John Kaiser seconded the motion. Motion PASSED.

Six (6) guests attended the meeting.

The bills against the Township were presented by the Supervisor, reviewed by the trustees and paid.

The bills against the Road District prepared by the Road Commissioner were presented by the Supervisor, discussed and paid.

SUPERVISOR'S REPORT

- The township received its seventh distribution from the county. The Town received \$5,656.89 and the Road received \$21,720.14.
- Mr. Karban updated on the recently discussed claim stated that the contractor and Toirma have been in contact but are still finalizing the cost of the claim.

HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER'S REPORT

- Commissioner Birkner reported that the concrete work has begun in Wildwood. He found that some work needs to be done in the cul-de-sac where a portion is starting to collapse. That repair was not included in the most recent bid and will be considered an emergency repair.

CLERK'S REPORT

- The Township building will be open on November 18 at 5pm to accept any filings for the upcoming April 1st election.


Public Comment:


