The regular monthly meeting of the highway commissioners of the State of Illinois, County of St. Clair, and Township of Prairie Du Long was held in the office of the town clerk at the Prairie Du Long Township Office Building on February 10, 2026 at 7:30 P.M.

Supervisor Mike Karban called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those present.

Mike Karban, Township Supervisor, presided over the meeting. Trustees John Kaiser, Tim Lubenkov, Douglas Hynes, Philip Lippert, Road Commissioner Gilbert Birkner and Township Clerk Dana Mehrmann were present.

Mr. Karban asked the Clerk to read the minutes from the previous meeting. Mr. Karban asked for questions or comments regarding the minutes. Philip Lippert motioned to accept the minutes as read. John Kaiser seconded the motion. Motion PASSED.

Three (3) guests attended the meeting.

The bills against the Township were presented by the Supervisor, reviewed by the trustees and paid.

The bills against the Road District prepared by the Road Commissioner were presented by the Supervisor, discussed and paid.

SUPERVISOR'S REPORT

- Supervisor Karban received notice from TOIRMA that they have not received out renewal packet. Gilbert would like to inquire if the building coverage amount covers contents (such as tools).
- Levy confirmations were received from the County. Mike and Gilbert have reviewed the numbers and will sign and return.
- Mike announced that the next election will be on March 17, 2026 and supply pickup is scheduled for March 11.
- Mr. Karban and Mr. Kaiser both attended the EMS meeting. In short, it was an informative event and it will be on the upcoming ballot.

HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER'S REPORT

- Commissioner Birkner stated that Wildwood was plowed twice during the most recent snow and because of the temperatures salt was not spread until two days after the snow.
- Gilbert noted that he received a call from a resident that needed to be plowed out for medical reasons and sent a truck out.
- Price for oil this year is \$2.58 per gallon (a two-cent increase from last year).

CLERK'S REPORT

- The township received a FOIA for a listing of transactions from January 1, 2025 thru January 26, 2026 that were not related to personnel. It has been responded to with the requested reports.
- Clerk Mehrmann reported that we received a Preliminary Notice Employer Compliance Review from IMRF.



There being no other business to be conducted a motion to adjourn was made by Douglas Hynes. Tim Lubenkov seconded the motion. Motion PASSED.


